













ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

Tools required to assembly the machine: Two Adjustable Wrenches and Allen Wrenches


STEP 1 (SEE DIAGRAM 1)

- A.) Connect the two Upright Beams (#1) & (#2) by a Cross Brace (#3) in the midspan. Secure them by with two M10 x 3 3/4 " Bolts (#43), one Bracket (#24) and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#29) on each end of the Cross Brace.
- B.) Place the Backrest Adjustment Bar (#7) between the two Upright Beams on the selected holes to obtain desired incline of Backrest.
- C.) Insert the Chrome Crutches (#6) into the top openings of the Upright Beams. Secure them with two Lock Knobs (#41) through selected holes to obtain desired height of the Supports.
- D.) Insert the Left and Right Safety Hooks (#17) & (#18) into the hole on each top of the Chrome Crutches (#6). Secure them with two M8 Aircraft Nuts (#30).
- E.) Attach the Main Seat Support (#4) to the Cross Brace (#3). Secure it with two M10 x 3 3/4 " Bolts (#43), one Bracket (#24) and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#29).
- F.) Attach the Front Stabilizer (#5) to the front end of the Main Seat Support (#4). Secure it with two M8 x 5/8" Allen Bolts (#47) and Ø 7/8" Band Washers (#33).




STEP 2 (SEE DIAGRAM 2)

- A.) Insert the Leg Developer Holder (#10) to the top opening on the Main Seat Support (#4). Secure it with a Lock Knob (#41) through a selected hole to obtain the desired height of the Leg Developer Holder (#10).
- B.) Attach the Leg Developer (#11) onto the bracket on the top of the Leg Developer Holder (#10). Insert an Axle (#22) into the hole on the Leg Developer Holder (#10). Secure it with two M8 x 5/8" Allen Bolts (#47) and Ø 3/4" Washers (#51).
- C.) Insert three Foam Roll Tubes (#15) halfway into the holes on the Leg Developer (#11). Push six Foam Rolls (#28) onto the Tubes from both sides. Push six Foam Round Plugs (#36) into the openings on the Tubes.
- D.) Install the U-Shape Hook (#21) to lock the Leg Developer in Place. Secure the Hook with a Ø 3/8" Spring Clip (#32). NOTE: Remove the Hook when using the Leg Developer.
- E.) Insert the Weight Holder (#16) halfway through the hole on the Leg Developer (#11). Push two Rubber Bumpers (#53) onto the Holder from both sides. Attach two Ø1" Spring Clips (#31) to the Holder.




STEP 3 (SEE DIAGRAM 3)


- A.) Attach hole-side of the Backrest Supports (#8) onto both end of the Pivot on the Main Seat Support (#4). The other side rest against the Backrest Adjustment Bar (#7). Attach the Incline Support (#9) to the holes in between the two Backrest Supports (#8).
- B.) Place the upholstered Backrest Board (#26) onto the Backrest Supports (#8). Secure it with four M6 x 1 3/8" Bolts (#45) and Ø ½ " Washers (#52).
- C.) Place the Seat (#25) onto the Seat Bracket (#13). Align the holes and fasten it with four M6 x 5/8" Bolts (#46) and ؽ" Washers (#52).
- D.) Attach the Seat Incline Support (#14) to the Seat Bracket (#13). Secure it with a M10 x Ø 43/4 " Bolt (#42) and M10 Aircraft Nut (#29).
- E.) Attach the Bracket and the Seat to the tube on the Main Seat Support (#4) and secure it with a M10 x Ø 4 ¾" Bolt (#42) and a M10 Aircraft Nut (#29).
- F.) Insert a 3 ¾" L-Shape Pin (#20) through the hole underneath the Seat to obtain the incline of the Seat. Secure the Pin with a Ø 3/8" Spring Clip (#32).



STEP 4 (See Diagram 4)

- A.) Attach the Arm Curl Pad (#27) to the Arm Curl Stand (#12). Secure it with two M8 x 5/8" Bolts (#44) and Ø 3/4" Washers (#51).
- B.) Remove the Leg Developer when using the Arm Curl.
